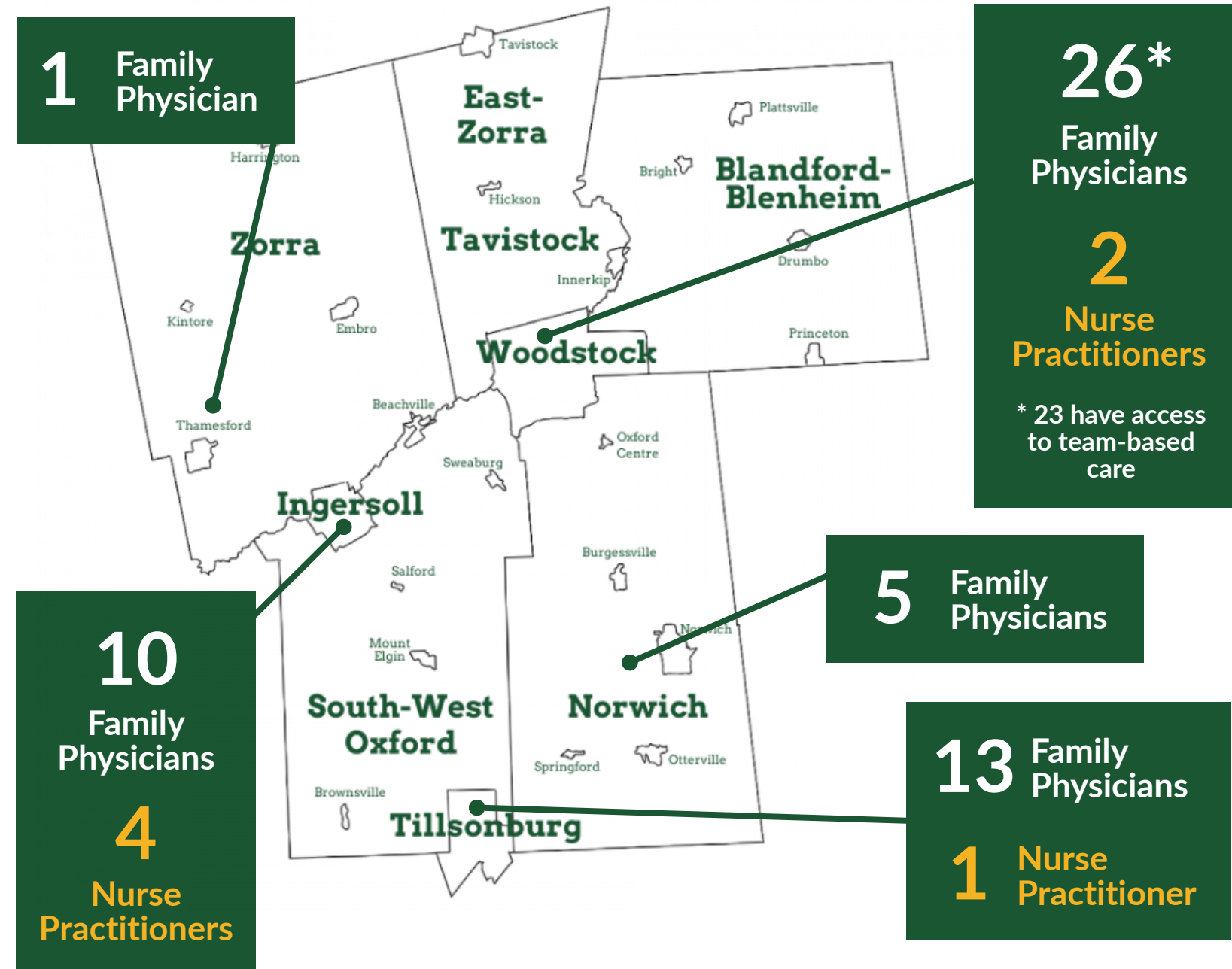

## Number of Primary Care Providers

- 55** Family Physicians in Oxford 1627 patients: average roster size (2nd highest in OH West)
- 19** Nurse Practitioners in Oxford 7 NPs roster patients with an average roster size of 800

## Additional responsibilities that Oxford Family Physicians undertake:

- Community On-Call Services
- Coronership
- Emergency Room Coverage
- Hospitalists
- Long Term Care Services
- Outpatient Oncology Clinic
- Palliative Care Outreach Team
- Surgical Assist



Oxford's anticipated population growth of **14,500 in 5 years** would require nine new Family Physicians
